

OPEN POSITION DESCRIPTION

TITLE: Teacher – Deaf Infant Program (DIP)

POSITION HOURS: Flexible Hours

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop an educational program for deaf infants/toddlers age birth – 3 years old and their families, with a focus on language development (oral and/or manual communication), auditory stimulation, cognitive development and parent education.
- Provide intervention services in the family’s home or other appropriate setting, such as a day care facility.
- Prepare, maintain and review Individualized Family Service Plans and conduct developmental assessments as required.
- Prepare and maintain session logs, progress reports, and other records as required.
- Communicate with other agencies/service providers as needed.
- Participate in periodic meetings at New York School for the Deaf campus.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- New York State certification as Teacher of the Deaf (TOD) or Teacher of the Speech and Hearing-Handicapped (TSHH)
- Masters degree in Deaf Education or other related field
- Must provide own transportation
- Fluency in or knowledge of American Sign Language
- Experience working with children aged birth to three preferred
- Experience working with families preferred
