**TITLE:** ASL Teacher

**POSITION SUMMARY:** Enhance ASL proficiency and provide assessment of ASL skills of students.

### **MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Teach ASL to K-12 students.
- Help develop or identify deaf studies curriculum for Pre-K through 12.
- Assess ASL linguistic and communication needs of students; write ASL assessment reports
- Propose strategies for improved ASL instruction and learning; work with teachers to implement strategies.
- Develop and identify materials/resources to support ASL instruction and learning in the classroom.
- Work with teachers to integrate deaf studies information in their lessons.
- Participate in multidisciplinary ASL evaluations of incoming students, as needed .
- Participate as member of the instructional team.
- Serve as educational resource person on issues related to deaf studies, ASL, and communication.
- Work with Family Infant Program (FIP)
- Along with ASL Specialist, coordinate annual school wide ASL Literacy event.
- Work closely with ASL Specialist and other ASL staff on relevant projects and strategies.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- NY State Certification or eligibility to become certified
- Fluency in American Sign Language
- Minimum of 3 years of teaching experience preferred
